

From the Illinois Lutheran Athletic Director,

To help make the athletic experience at Illinois Lutheran better for everyone involved and in an effort to improve communication, please take note of the following:

- 1) When to come to the Athletic Director
 - concerns about a coach
 - concerns about the behavior of any spectator
 - safety issues (the coach should be made aware of your concern also)
 - schedule concerns (the coach has input and could be approached as well)
 - an idea to improve our school
 - volunteer to help our school
 - questions about why we do what we do

- 2) When not to come to the Athletic Director
 - playing time questions (this is best communicated between the player and the coach and parents should generally encourage this as the best way to get questions answered)

 - game strategy concerns (the coach is doing what he/she feels is best and is also relying on assistant coaches)

- 3) Sportsmanship – Illinois Lutheran is striving to be a model for good sportsmanship from coaches, players, and fans. We expect good sportsmanship from everyone. Please do your part.

- 4) Concessions – The money we generate with concessions is vital to our programs and everyone is expected to help out. If your schedule absolutely prevents you from ever helping out, please speak to the Athletic Director.

- 5) Purpose of the Participation Fee - Transportation is only a part of our expense – there are also coaching salaries, official expenses, association fees, equipment and supplies to buy, uniforms to buy, etc... \$100 helps defray those costs.

- 6) Athletes should be expected to be pushed to excel, to be held to a high standard, and to be treated with respect.
