## Illinois Lutheran High School and Junior High Back to School Plan

### Health & Safety Plan

- All faculty and staff will be screened daily upon entering the building for fever and flu like symptoms.
- All students will be screened daily for fever and flu like symptoms.
- Any person exhibiting fever or flu like symptoms will be isolated and sent home.
- All students, staff, faculty and visitors will be required to wear a mask while in the building.
- Hand sanitizer is located in each classroom.
- Good hand washing will be stressed.
- Social distancing will be practiced in the halls and as much as is possible in the classrooms and common areas.
- Students will be given outside breaks whenever possible.
- Student arrival and dismissal times and locations will be staggered.

### Building Safety & Sanitation

- All classrooms will be sanitized each day with electrostatic sprayer and disinfectant.
- Common areas; bathrooms, tables, doors, etc. will be sanitized more frequently.
- Drinking fountains will not be in service. Students should bring bottled water.

### Instructional Procedures (Two Options)

- **Option #1:** Face-to-face instruction will be offered 5 days per week on a regular schedule.
- **Option #2:** Online eLearning in real time will be available through a video feed option for students not wishing to attend in person for family health reasons.
- Students absent due to sickness may attend eLearning for days absent.
- Parents will need to select a method of instruction on a full time basis, and must request a change in advance. Registration for this method will be coming soon.

### Instructional Option # 3 if required by State of Illinois

- Students will be divided by families into two groups, Group A and Group B.
- Group "A" will attend classes in school on Mondays and Thursdays and have online eLearning on Tuesday and Friday.
- Group "B" will attend in school classes on Tuesday and Friday and have eLearning Classes on Monday and Thursday.
- Wednesday will be an eLearning Day for all students.

### Lunches

- Students will need to bring their own lunches for the first few weeks of school. After that a modified lunch program will be offered. Outside food services will not be accepted (Door Dash Grub Hub, etc).

### Early Release for Seniors

- All seniors, except those with a failing grade or late work, will receive the senior privilege of early release and may leave school at 2:29 PM.

### School Office Business Hours

- The High School Office will be open during regular hours 7:45 AM to 3:30 PM.
- Items for drop off can be delivered through the "pass through window" located in the entrance of the building, without being screened.
- Parents and visitors that need to come into the school for business will need to be screened for temperature and flu like symptoms.
- Parents wishing to speak to a teacher should call ahead and arrange a time.
- To avoid congestion we ask that parents avoid coming to the office during morning drop off and screening times.

### School Illness

- We are relying on parents to self-screen their children before bringing them to school. Please check carefully for fever or any flu-like symptoms.
- Students with a fever must remain out of school for 72 hours. This is a new CDC guideline.
- Students contracting COVID 19 must remain out of school until two consecutive tests for the virus are negative.
- Children directly exposed to COVID 19 must self-quarantine at home for 14 days. During this time eLearning will be provided.
- Students and staff will follow the same protocol for illnesses.

### Attendance

- This year we are not following the targeted attendance policy for first semester tests. Perfect attendance will not exempt students from taking final exams.
- However, we are following our normal attendance requirements and taking daily attendance on a class by class basis.
- Attendance will be taken for in-school and eLearning classes.
- Both will count for total attendance.
